



## 5. Dominical

Dominical, a beach-front town, is located in Bahia Ballena de Osa district in the province of Puntarenas, Costa Rica. It is nestled about 27 mi (44 km) south of Quepos and the gorgeous Manuel Antonio National Park. This tiny coastal town is a surfer's paradise where waves can reach over 10 feet high. This laid back beach town is surrounded by plantations, mangroves, estuaries and marshes. It began as a small fishing village but has grown into a tourist attraction, mostly for the surfers. Dominical not only attracts surfers from across the country but also from all over the world .

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### Arrival

- Because the bus continues travel to Uvita, its final destination, the bus will stop on the main road near the entrance to Dominical
- Upon stopping, ensure you receive any excess baggage that may have been checked into the cargo space
- Unlike Quepos, Dominical is a tiny village that really caters to surfers. There are a number of attractions that include a market located near the beach, several restaurants, souvenir stores, car rental agencies, and several retail stores,
- Wifi spots are readily available at most establishments, so if you need to get on the internet, find a local cafe to logon
  - Cafe Mono Congo is the preferred place to go to acquire a wifi connection and also get a nice cool beverage
