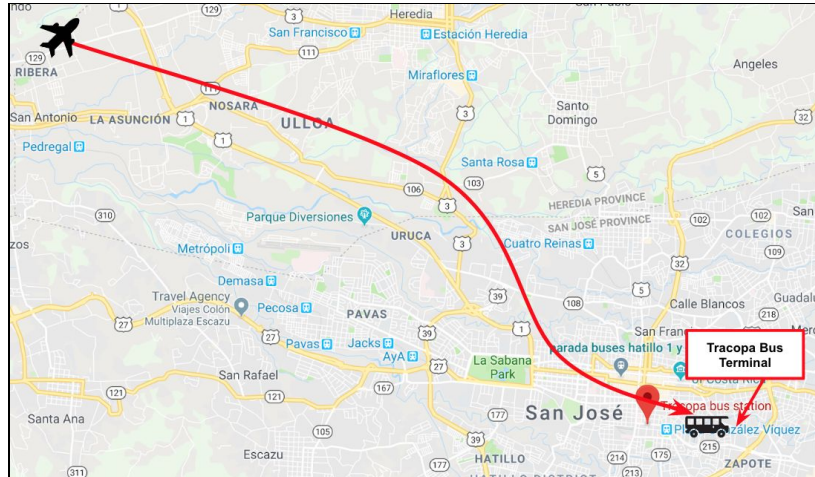




### 3. Tracopa Bus Terminal

The Tracopa Bus Terminal is located approximately 30 minutes, traffic / weather dependent, from SJO and is the hub for all buses headed to the west coast of Costa Rica.



#### Details

- Address: Calle 5, San José Province, San José, Costa Rica
- Phone Number: +506 2221 4214
- One way bus ticket costs ~ \$7.50 and is subject to fluctuate
- Bus departure times to Quepos:
  - 6:00 a.m., 9:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., 2:30 p.m., 6:00 p.m
- Bus departure times for Dominical
  - 6:00 a.m., 3:00 p.m. (These buses also stop at Quepos)
- A taxi or Uber can be used to get to the bus terminal. Cost of taxi should not exceed \$20 USD; Uber is probably the most cost effective





## Departing Bus Terminal and Travel

- Plan on arriving at least 45 minutes to the terminal to purchase your ticket
- There is no wifi at the terminal or on the bus
- Buses *normally* depart on time; pay attention to the time
- When loading the bus, you will be asked to provide the copy (copia) of your ticket to the driver; you keep the original (See photo below)
- A seat (asiento) will be indicated on the ticket, this is your assigned seat on the bus. The number of the seat will be displayed either in the headrest or above. Sometimes, there may not be a seat number associated, so don't panic, just sit where you feel comfortable.



- Any extra baggage will be tagged by the bus driver and placed in the cargo space underneath the bus. Any items of value should be maintained on your person at all times or in your carry-on.
- Bus ride to Quepos is approximately four hours but can vary depending on traffic and weather
- One twenty minute rest stop will be provided about halfway through the trip; bring some cash so you can purchase snacks and beverages
